Classes include Prospects in Hand, Breed Stock in Hand, Sport Horse Under Saddle, Materiale and Individual Breed

## Held in conjunction with Dressage at Stone Tavern

### Young Horse/Dressage Horse Prospect

*Shall be shown in hand on the triangle at the walk and trot. Halters mandatory on foals. Bridles are optional on yearlings, but mandatory on all 2 year olds. Mares accompanying foals must wear bridles and issued a separate bridle number. Scoring will be weighted 60% Movement, 30% conformation, 10% General Impression.*

- B1 Fillies of 2010 (with or without dam); judged foal only
- B2 Filly Yearlings
- B3 Filly 2 Year Olds
- B4 Filly 3 Year Olds
- B5 **Filly Championship** – Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places in Classes B2, B3, B4  
(Great American Insurance Group/USDFBC)
- B6 Colts/Geldings of 2010 (with or without dam); judged foal only
- B7 Colts/Gelding Yearlings
- B8 Colt/Gelding 2 Year Olds
- B9 Colt/Gelding 3 Year Olds
- B10 **Colt/Gelding Championship** – Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places in classes B7, B8, B9  
(Great American Insurance Group/USDFBC)
- B11 **Foal Championship** – Open to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places in classes B1 and B6
- B12 **Young Horse Championship** -Open to Championship & Reserve from classes B5 and B10

### Mature Horses/Dressage Breeding Stock

*Mature horses shall be shown in hand on the triangle at the walk and trot. Bridles are mandatory. Scoring will be weighed 50% Movement, 40% Conformation, 10% General Impression.*

- B13 Broodmares. 4 Years and Older (with or without foals) mares only judged
- B14 Maiden/Yeld Mares 4 Years and Older
- B15 **Mare Championship** – Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places in classes B13 & B14  
(Great American Insurance Group/USDFBC)
- B16 Stallions, 4 Years and Older (shown only in-hand at this show)
- B17 Stallions, 4 Years and Older (shown in hand and under saddle at this show)
- B18 **Stallion Championship** – Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places in Classes B16 & B17  
(Great American Insurance Group/USDFBC)
- B19 **Mature Horse Championship** – Open to Champion & Reserve from classes B15 & B18
- B20 **Grand Championship** – Open to Champion & Reserve from classes B12 & B19

### **Other Classes:**

B21 Amateur Handler – Open to any Amateur or Junior/Young Rider handler.

Horses shall be shown-in-hand on the triangle at the walk and trot. Horses must be owned by the handler or a member of the handler's family – no leased or borrowed horses allowed. To be judged on presentation and condition of animal and the neatness and appearance of the handler. Conformation will not be the determining factor, but may count 15%. Classes are intended to stimulate participation of the amateur breeding divisions, but does not limit amateurs to this class. No colts of stallions except for weanlings.

### **Under Saddle Classes**

*To be shown at the walk, trot and canted, both ways of the ring. To be scored 60% movement, 30% confirmation (score from in-hand class will not be transferred) and 10% general impression (including balance, impulsion and rideability). Horses entered in the following classes are not required to have shown in any in-hand classes.*

B22 Mares under saddle – 3 years old and older

B23 Stallions/geldings under saddle – 3 years and older

B24 Suitable to become a Dressage Horse – Open to any horse of any sex between 3 and 6 years of age that has not competed above first level

B25 Materiale Mares (Classe may be split by horse's age if entries warrant)

B26 Materiale Geldings/Stallions (Classes may be split by horse's age if entries warrant)

### **Individual Breed Classes (IBC)**

B26 Open to horses of any age. Classes will be broken into breed specific subgroups based on the number of entries by breed. Breed specific classes and/or futurities are dependent upon the number of entries. Check website for updates
