Exhibition Class: The Garden State Combined Driving Event is pleased to host a Junior Drivers Class. Junior Drivers, for the purposes of this event, will be divided into 2 classes. Class 1 will be for drivers under 12 years of age, and Class 2 will be for drivers, 12 – 16 years of age. For the purposes of this event, both of these classes will drive the USEF Training Level Test 1. Marathon will follow all USEF Training Level Rules. There will be 4 obstacles, with drivers required to do Gates A, B and C. The cones competition will consist of 16 cones, and will drive at 180 mpm. Entry Fee for Junior Drivers will be waived, however, they will be required to pay the stabling fee and drug fee.

Exhibition Class: The Garden State Combined Driving Event is pleased to offer Standardbred Off the Track (SOT) Class. To qualify horse must be a registered Standardbred and have raced. For purposes of this event, this class will follow USEF Training Level Rules, with certain excepttions. This class will drive USEF Training Level Test 1. There will be 2 obstacles on the marathon course, with drivers required to drive gates A, B and C. The cones competition will consist of 16 cones, to be driven at 180 mpm, with a clearance of 35 cm.

Acceptance of entries

Entries are accepted on a first come first serve basis. The organizer reserves the right to refuse any entry, cancel or add classes/divisions, or change the time schedule, as determined by the number of entries received. Sharing requests must be made in writing to the secretary, by completing the Special Request for Sharing Form made a part of this prizelist. Requests may or may not be granted based on scheduling parameters.

Show Pass will be available for purchase on-line only and Show Pass data will be available to competition secretaries through the web service and API.

VETERINARY AND HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Every horse entering the Horse Park grounds must present:

- Negative Coggins test valid within 1 year
- Flu/Rhino vaccination valid within 6 months
- A Health Certificate issued within 30 days for horses entering from outside the state of New Jersey

STABLING

- Permanent stalls, board and chain link, full doors
- No straw bedding allowed
- \$50 stall deposit per stall required. Please make check payable to Horse Park of New Jersey.
- Stabling fee covers arrival Wednesday, October 5 departure Sunday, October 9.
- Early stabling is available for \$40 per stall per night with written permission from secretary.
- Receptacles are provided in the stable area, as per USEF GR 1210.4 for the safe disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. Management will fine individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments.

GROOMS ON CARRIAGES

The OC highly recommends that athletes have a groom on the carriage at all times, please do your best to comply with this request, or if it is impossible to have a groom on the carriage, have a groom in attendance to render assistance if needed.

DOG POLICY

Dogs must be leashed at all times. The owner of any dog found off leash will be fined \$75.

USEF SAFESPORT REMINDER

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THERE WITH.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above Individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. USEF GR901.29

SHARPS CONTAINER STATEMENT

Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Competition management will place a notice of this requirement either in its prize list or on a specific handout given to trainers on check in at the competition. If local law has different requirements, local law will prevail. Competitions failing to comply with placing the required number of containers on the show grounds will be considered in violation of the rules and may be subject to penalty as determined by the CEO or his designee and/ or the Hearing Committee.
